Calving Area:

- Use individual calving pens that are cleaned after each use.
- Keep calving area clean and dry.
- Keep adult cow manure away from calves.
- Do not use calving pens for sick cows or cows that are JD test positive.
- Remove calves from calving area immediately after they are born.
- Do not allow calves to nurse.
- Collect colostrum under sanitary conditions.

Pre-weaned Calves:

- Do not feed pooled colostrum or milk.
- Pasteurize milk before feeding to calves.
- Prevent contact with adult cows or cow manure.
- Prevent contact with cows that are JD test positive.
- Provide adequate pasture space.
- Wear clean coveralls and boots and use clean equipment when working with or feeding calves.

Weaned calves and bred heifers:

- Minimize contact with adult cows or cow manure.
- Remove cow manure from all equipment before using in heifer areas.
- Do not feed heifers refused (weigh-back) feed from cows.
- Do not allow heifers to share water, feed, housing, feed bunks or pasture with cows.

Adult cows and bulls:

- Avoid spreading manure on hay ground or pasture.
- Avoid manure contamination of feed storage areas or feeding equipment.
- Isolate or cull cows that are JD test positive.

Replacements:

- Management herds - Purchase replacements from herds with known negative JD status.
- Status herds - Purchase replacements according to guidelines for negative Status Herds.
