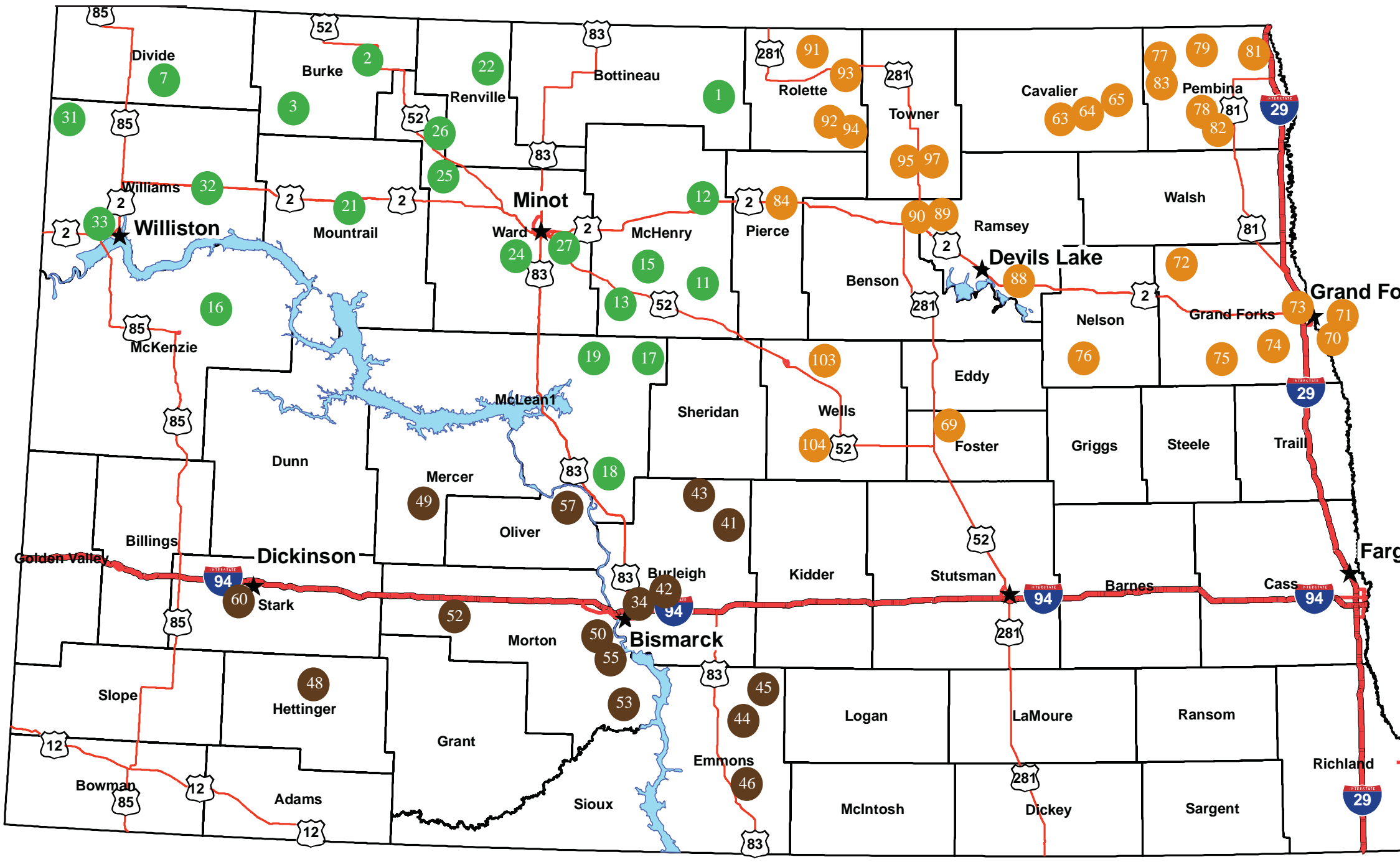

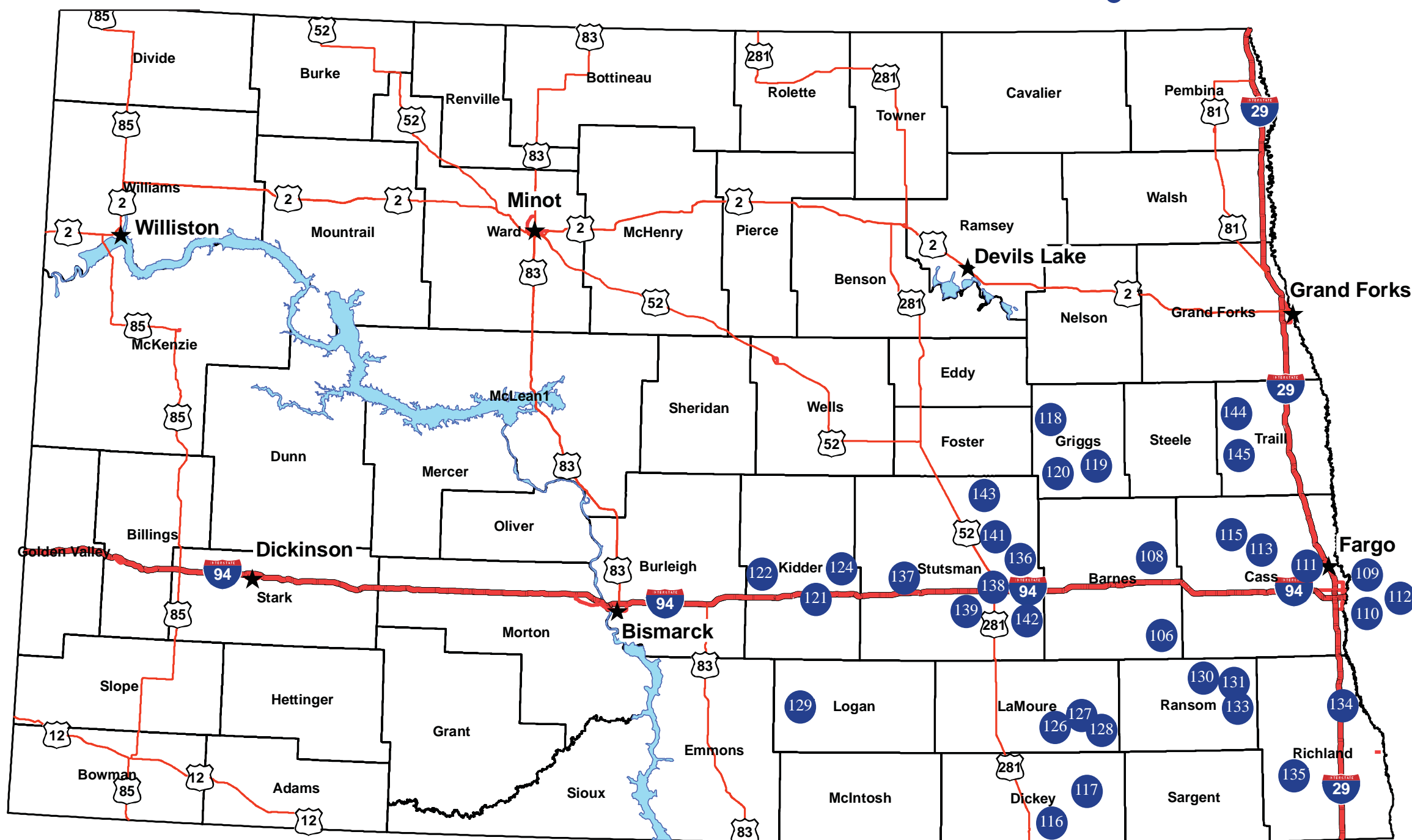

Membership in the North Dakota Farmers Market and Growers Association is available to everyone who is engaged in the production or promotion or direct marketing of freshly grown or processed North Dakota products.

**Farmers Market Members:** This option is open to all formally organized farmers markets that are actively engaged in direct marketing of locally grown or processed North Dakota products. Each farmers market manager is responsible for updating and providing a current list of vendors to the NDFMGA in the fall of each year and is responsible for updating those lists as necessary. Registered vendors listed on the submitted vendor list shall receive all benefits of membership via their farmers market. Farmers Market Members will pay dues according to the number of vendors at each market: (vendor numbers will be based on previous year).

- <5 vendors - \$50 per year
- 5-20 vendors - \$100 per year
- 20+ vendors - \$150 per year

**Individual Member:** Businesses or individuals not members of a farmers market and engaged in the production and direct marketing of locally grown or processed North Dakota products may apply for an Individual Membership. Membership dues are \$25 per year, per business. If applying for an Individual Membership, you must not be selling at a NDFMGA farmers market member event function.

**Friends of the Market:** This sponsorship option is available to all persons, local or regional groups or organizations who engage in the furthering of the NDFMGA and its purposes. There are four sponsorships available:

- Bronze - \$100 per year
- Silver - \$200 per year
- Gold - \$350 per year
- Platinum - \$500 per year


