Feral Swine Protocol

When Feral Swine are Sighted:

Do not destroy the animals.

Contact the Animal Health Division @ 701-328-2655.*

The Animal Health Division will work cooperatively with other state and federal agencies to determine origin and either capture or destroy the animals.

If an individual has already destroyed the animal, contact the Animal Health Division immediately.

The Animal Health Division will make arrangements to have the entire carcass collected for disease surveillance.

Feral swine CAN NOT be processed for consumption.

*Outside of regular business hours, callers to the Animal Health Division will hear a message which provides emergency contact numbers.
